

Terms and Conditions - Universal Yoga Teacher Training

Practice Experience:

Students need to have been practising yoga for 2 years before embarking on the Universal Yoga TTC.

Booking:

£600 deposit required at time of booking.

Balance to be paid ideally 2 months before the start of the course but there is flexibility.

Booking is on a first come first served basis.

Universal Yoga reserves the right to refuse a place to students who have not paid their deposit or fees in full by the required date.

What fees include/What is not included?

Included:

- Training and assessment by qualified Yoga Alliance Professionals (SYT)
- Subsidised trainee membership with Yoga Alliance Professionals (pls include all students name and email addresses to be forwarded to YAP (and no other third parties) to be approved for their free membership and upgrade.
- Subsidised join up fee (saving £35.00) if YA membership is upgraded within 14 days of graduation.
- Full manual provided
- All food and accommodation included.

Not Included:

- UY does not automatically insure all UK/Eire trainees. YAP grants insurance to graduates for £15 a year through Balens Ltd.

Refund Policy

Deposit payment (non refundable) to be made asap to secure place on the course.

Any adverse circumstances with health, family or finance will allow a student to pull out of the course. The deposit will be maintained by Universal Yoga. An agreement will be made as to how much of the course fee will be refunded depending on time of cancellation.

Cancellation procedure: contact info@universalyoga.co.uk with evidence behind reason for cancellation.

During the course, all sessions are to be attended. Any time off needs to be caught up via skype or in person at an additional cost of £450 per day. The course must be finished within one year of the final training day.

Additional charge for resitting any assignments is charged at £450 per day.

The expectation of daily practice expected of students is outlined in the manual.

Extensions permissible for those students unable to complete requirements of the course due to unforeseen circumstances but not beyond the end of year of study. Evidence will be required if this is the case.

31st October is date by which Universal Yoga will decide to run the course or not so 2 months notice of potential cancellation of course will be given.

Complaints Procedure

Stage 1 – informal chat on day

Stage 2 – Written complaint. Responded to within a week. Universal Yoga will make every effort to keep complaints anonymous.

Stage 3 - If it is not possible to provide a full answer within a week Universal Yoga will provide a letter outlining the reasons why and give a date by which a full answer is expected.

Thank you for joining our 200 hour diploma course and a warm welcome to the Universal Yoga Family.

We hope you enjoy the course, finding it useful and informative. In order to maintain high standards and ensure that we keep our good reputation, it is important that you reach a certain minimum standard. Whenever we feel this is not the case we will talk to you privately and try to amend the situation. The assessment is on a continuous basis and you will receive feedback on your progress. Students who do not meet the required standards will be asked to improve upon the areas of weakness and demonstrate that they have done this, before being issued with a certificate.

This Code of Conduct is a summation and declaration of acceptable ethical and professional behaviour by which all Yoga Alliance Professionals Registered Yoga Teachers agree to conduct the teaching and business of Yoga.

As a registrant of Universal Yoga Teacher Training, I agree to uphold the ethical goals set forth in the following Code of Conduct:

1. To ensure that safe and effective teaching is available to the public.
2. To provide the public with access to safe and effective yoga teachers.
3. To maintain and uphold the traditions of Hatha Yoga. To teach yoga from the experience of these traditions and to disseminate these teachings to anyone, from any background, who earnestly desires to follow these traditions.
4. Uphold the integrity of my vocation by conducting myself in a professional and conscientious manner.
5. Acknowledge the limitations of my skills and scope of practice and where appropriate, refer students to seek alternative instruction, advice, treatment or direction.
6. Create and maintain a safe, clean and comfortable environment for the practice of yoga.
7. Actively encourage diversity by respecting all students regardless of age, physical limitations, race, creed, gender, ethnicity, religious affiliation or sexual orientation.
8. Respect the rights, dignity and privacy of all students.
9. Avoid words and actions that constitute sexual harassment.
10. Follow all local government and national laws that pertain to my yoga teaching and business.

I agree to comply with the conditions and requirements as set out in the course curriculum and accept that failure to do so will disqualify me from any accreditation. I furthermore vow to uphold the standards of the teachings I have been given and to maintain and promote the good name of yoga at all times. I accept that failure to do so may lead to the annulment of any accreditation obtained from Universal Yoga Teacher Training.
